It is important to always be prepared in case of natural disasters. In order to protect your family and yourself, have discussions with your family on how you could contact one another and find your nearest evacuation site* in advance.

The 1-2-3s of Safety Behavior in case of an Earthquake

In the Event of an Earthquake

Secure Your Safety

Put your safety first and protect yourself from falling objects by, e.g. taking cover under a table. Protect your head with particular care and stay still until the shaking subsides. If you are outdoors in the event of an earthquake, use something like your bag or your briefcase to protect your head, and remember to move away from tottering buildings such as cement fences.

Immediately After an Earthquake

Prevent Fire from Sources

After the shaking subsided, double check all sources of fire, and turn off gas at the main. At the same time, make sure to turn off the breaker in order to prevent electric fire accidents when power is restored.

Cautions after an Earthquake

Take Precautions for Aftershocks

After a particularly large earth quake, there is a high probability that an aftershock will follow. Aftershocks may trigger the collapse of buildings that were damaged in the initial earthquake.

Snarled information is promised in disasters. We advise you to make good use of battery-powered portable radios or cell phones to help you obtain information that is accurate.

Stockpile Food, Water and other Basic Essentials

Suginami City has designated its municipal public elementary schools and junior high schools as evacuation sites (for shelter and assistance) in case of a massive earthquake. Evacuation sites are equipped with emergency food stockpiles and emergency-use equipment. We advise you to make sure where you can find such sites Drills are held at each designated evacuation site, mainly during the period from September to November. It will help

you learn where you can find the help that you need, or how to handle various pieces of emergency-use equipment.

In an event of a major earthquake, telephone connections could be bad. Make good use of services such as the NTT Disaster Emergency Message Dial (171) or emergency message services provided by each cell phone carrier. Having other contacting options such as SNS ready is also advisable.

Each household should have three-day's worth of emergency food and drinking water supplies (three liters per person per day) ready and stocked, as well as portable toilets. To ensure smooth evacuation, it is wise to prepare a back-pack contained with necessities such as emergency provisions, radio, flashlight, or your household medicines) so that both of your hands will not be occupied, together with a pair of flat shoes that are easy to walk in

Suginami City provides emergency supplies (intermediary service) for purchase. Please refer to the Guide to our Intermediary Service for Emergency Supplies (Bosai Yohin Assen no Goannai), details available at the Suginami City Office, Residents Offices, Annex Offices, and Community Halls.

Prevent Furniture from Tipping

Take necessary measures such as using tip-resistant equipment in order to prevent furniture from tipping or glass windows from shattering and scattering.

If you are Covered by National Health Insurance, **Please Declare your Income**

National Health Insurance premiums are calculated based on your total income of the previous year. For those who do not have obligations to file residents/income tax due to low income, it is still a duty to submit such declaration to the City.

Without a declaration, households with a low income will not be given deduction for their national health insurance premiums.

If you are registered a resident of Suginami City as of January 1st, 2014 please file your residents tax. Declaration cards are available at the Taxation Section (Suginami City Office, East Wing 2F), Residents Offices, and station-front Residents Offices.

Notification of National Health Insurance premiums will be mailed out in mid-June after the status of your income of the previous year have been confirmed. Please make payments within the term starting at June through March the next year, in 10 installments. These payments will cover the 12 months (from April 2014 through March 2015).

If you are covered by a social insurance program, you must complete the designated procedures to withdraw from National Health Insurance. Please contact us for more details.


